EARSC is a trade association (NGO), founded in 1989, which represents companies: offering services (including consulting), supplying equipment in the field of remote sensing or using EO data.

- to foster the development of the European Geo-Information Service Industry
- Today, 75 members (65 full members / 10 observers) from 23 countries

R&D: Provide views to institutional stakeholders on industry needs
Perception that EO services view is missing from previous consultations

- Excellent base of R&D in Europe through FP and ESA
- There remains a gap before this is commercialised

Copernicus: Strong EU investment in new capabilities, Sentinel satellites and Copernicus Services:

? How to enable the private sector to commercialise?

H2020: Setting industrial priorities (see later slides)

ESA: Focus is on manufacturing segment : need to also work on applications of EU satellites and technologies through the downstream sector.

GEO: Provides only international political platform for exchange dedicated to EO.

Engagement with the private sector : but what does this mean?
Need a dialogue with the EO services sector as a priority.

EO Services Industry Sector Profile

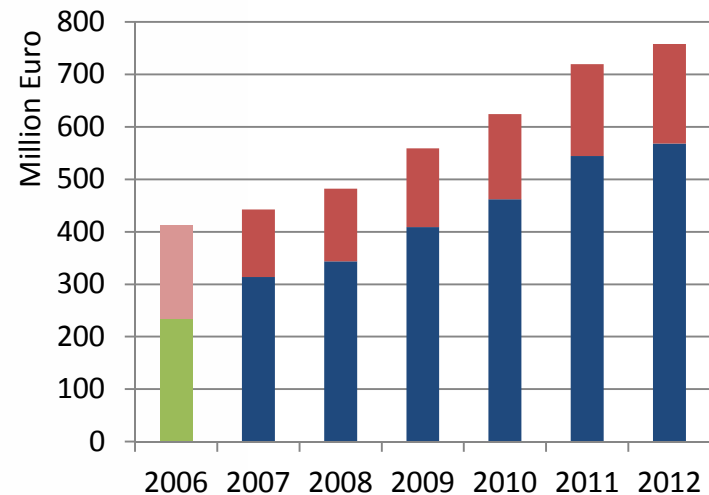
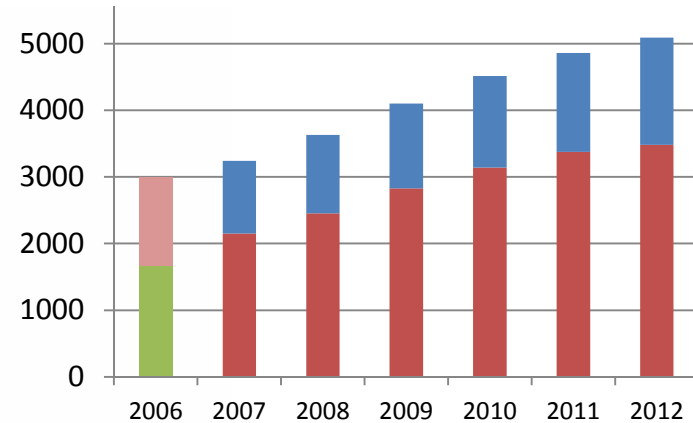
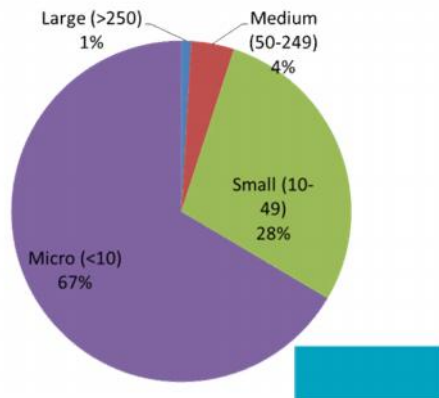
Key Facts From EARSC 2013 Industry Survey

5087 = Total number of employees in 2012

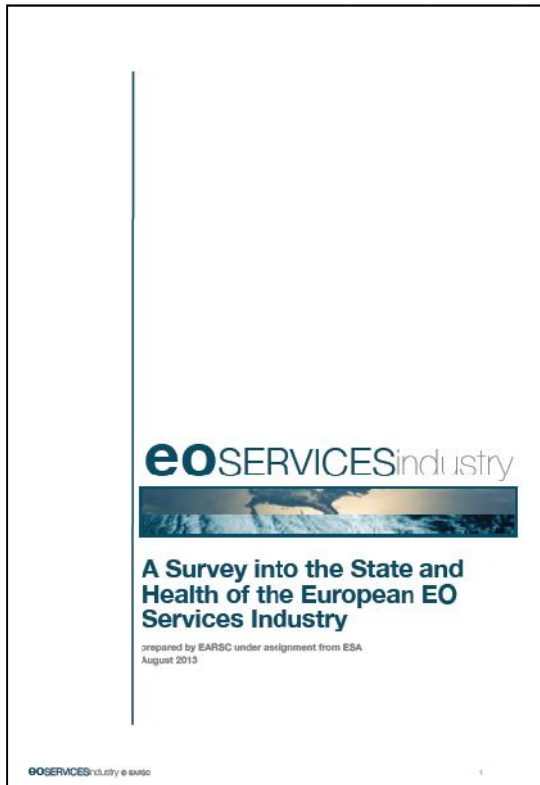
€757m = Total Revenues for the sector in 2012

LET'S EMBRACE SPACE / 15 - 17 September 2014 - Rome, Italy



- Last survey based on our database of 365 companies throughout EU and Canada.
- New survey will start in October to provide update on the state and health of the industry; database holds over 500 companies in Europe.
- Extend coverage to include all sector employment in Europe and the projected use of Copernicus data and information
- Include international figures linked to Copernicus.
- Survey results expected in June 2015.
- In future, plan an annual update with limited but key data.

Support requested from all companies and national contact points to ensure coverage is as full as possible.

R&D Priorities – Linked to Copernicus

- Thematic research for 6 Copernicus services improve products, quality, accuracy
- Improve procurement process; product standards and certification
- New architectures ; improve quality and processing chain efficiency
- Integration of different data sources
- Understanding user requirements ; translation!

R&D Priorities – Market enabling

- Raising awareness of the capabilities of EO services and products related to the customers own processes.
- Innovative distribution and dissemination techniques to public and private customers linked to innovative payment and production systems and architectures.
- Risk reduction and means to underpin new business models of LowCapEx models,
- Product specification and standardisation / certification processes.
- Means to develop and enter new markets with customers outside of the EU ie exports.

R&D Priorities – Technology Development

- Integration of data from multiple sources eg. satellite, aircraft, UAV, balloon, ship, sub-sea, crowd etc.
- Means to access data sources with intelligent front-ends integrated with processing chains.
- Deep knowledge of scenes and metadata to permit and enable automatic imagery selection and extraction.
- Market oriented platforms which allow users to quickly acquire the information which they seek which will also allow suppliers and new route to market.
- Find ways to encourage new private initiatives based on private investment. Use of prizes and progressive funding approaches.

Recent & Current EARSC Actions (contd)

- Develop and deepen Community links with O&G industry and IFI's
 - OGEO workshop on 19th November in London
 - OGEO Portal and support to eo4og projects (ESA)
 - OGEOZine : quarterly magazine for OGEO network
- Develop tools to support the industry in export markets
 - Export workshop held in June
 - Developing export centre with information on resources available to industry
 - Exploring export mission possibilities
- EARSC Certification Scheme;
 - Trial of Management certification (ISO9001) based on 1st workshop in April 2013
 - Workshop in London on 19th November
 - Recognised suppliers and product specifications for information products





R&D Priorities Summary

- Global environment is changing rapidly and EU effort is needed to maintain leading capability.
- Stronger industrial involvement in decisions and concerted R&D effort to help industry and especially SME's bring new ideas to the market:
 - Build upon investments made in Copernicus
 - Deliver improved products and services to EU public sector customers
 - Build export capabilities
- Sustained investment: EC and ESA can both play complementary roles
 - sustained investment through the “Valley of Death” up to demonstrable products with a confirmed customer base
 - Progressive but flexible funding (more use of prizes?)
 - Industry-led R&D with commitment for later stage research.
- Develop partnership through a European Research Roadmap for EO Services.
